The 10th G200 Youth Forum 2015 will take place in Garmisch-Partenkirchen, Bavaria, Germany (120 km from Munich «Franz-Josef-Strauß» airport), from 29 April to 3 May 2015.

The G200 Youth Forum will be one of the largest international events organized for young leaders from around 200 countries in 2015, and about 500 young leaders, members of parliaments and young parliamentarians, students and academics, representatives of the business world, governments and international organizations will be participating in it.

The G200 Youth Forum 2015 has 4 main platforms which will run in tandem with each other:

- G20 Youth Summit – resulting in the Communiqué;
- Conference – with publication of academic articles in the Conference Proceedings;
- International Young Parliamentarians' Debate – with Joint Statement;
- Joint Sessions – Results.

We would like to invite you to nominate a maximum of 10 parliamentarians to participate at our International Young Parliamentarians' Debate.

Young Parliamentarians' Debate is a meeting of international parliamentarians from different countries, who are under 45 years of age, with the purpose of exchanging ideas and experience in all the aspects of creating and implementing legislation.

The objective of the International Young Parliamentarians' Debate is to create and sign a joint statement and declaration of cooperation between all the young parliamentarians.

During the International Young Parliamentarians' Debate around 200 participants from state parliaments and youth parliaments of G20 countries will discuss common problems in the format of 5 groups working in parallel:

- 1) Committee on women's rights, family, child support and welfare;
- 2) Committee on sport and youth policy, culture, education and media;
- 3) Committee on legal framework, international law;
- 4) Committee on business and entrepreneurship, innovations and energy;
- 5) Committee on local development, sustainability, transport and tourism.

The Joint Statement will be disseminated throughout the world and shared, in particular, with the G-20 Heads of States and leading international organizations such as IMF, World Bank, OECD, European Commission and Basel Committee on Banking Supervision.

The Young Parliamentarians' Debate adds value not only to the G200 leaders' efforts in responding to the global economic and financial challenges, but also it serves as a unique opportunity for the participants to gather together in an exchange of ideas and best practice, encouraging stronger personal and professional relationships.

Upon receipt of your recommendations, we undertake to consider positively the application of your nominees.

Please make sure that your nominee receives the enclosed information and application form.

Your nomination letter, together with a short description of your candidate's profile, talents and achievements and your nominee's applications should reach the G8 & G20 Alumni Association no later than 28 February 2015. It should also be sent by e-mail to g20youth@g200youthforum.org.

- a) The Nomination letter with a short description of your candidate's profile, talents and achievements must be sent by e-mail to 20youth@g200youthforum.org no later than 28 February 2015.
- b) Candidates must:
 - be a member of a federal, regional or city Parliament of the G200 countries;
 - be a member of a federal, regional or city Youth Parliament of the G200 countries;
 - be aged between 18 and 45;
 - have good communications skills in English.

- b) Curriculum Vitae;

The participation fee must be received within 5 days of notification to the candidate that his/her application has been successful.
